New Features and Improvements

- .ORB and .CSV files are now retrieved along with other Matrikon configuration files
- Total and available physical memory are now reported
- Windows event logs are now retrieved
- IP configuration settings are now retrieved

Known Limitations

MatrikonOPC Analyzer has the following limitations:

- **Microsoft Windows NT is not supported** – MatrikonOPC Analyzer will not execute if running on the Windows NT operating system.
- Some information, such as log or configuration files, is not gathered when the MatrikonOPC server is not installed in the default directory.
- User must be part of the Administrators Group in order for full output.
- READ/WRITE access is required for the output directory.
